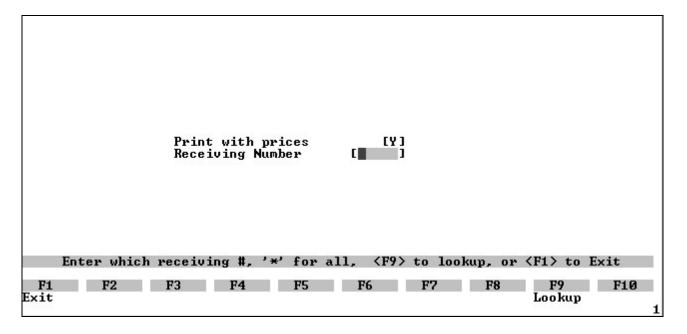
## Menu Plate: BECIJ

In previous versions, users wishing to print labels for each receiving order separately had to receive each order one at a time, print the labels, and then clear the label file. Version 7.1 now allows the user to process the printing of labels by receiving order.

(For those sites not using target margins and bin labels to stay on top of cost increases, watch for an upcoming bulletin on margin management.)

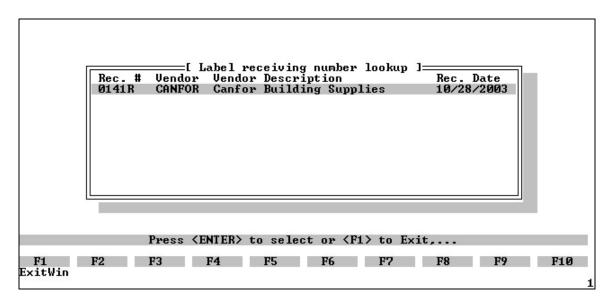
Version 7.1 now allows you to process multiple receiving orders before printing labels. Label printing programs have been modified to prompt the user to input a receiving number. This method allows the user to print labels based on a single receiving order if they wish.

The new receiving bin label prompt looks like this:

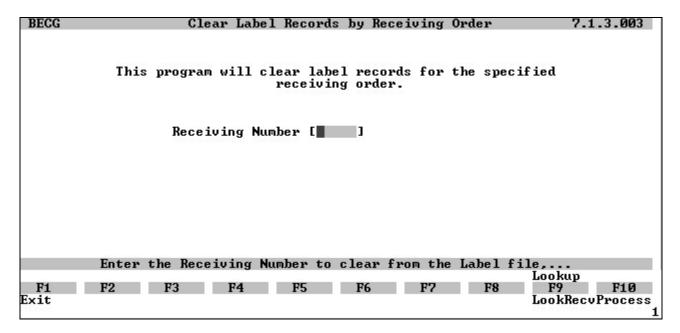


## **Bulletin 0003 – Label Printing continued**

The F9 key will display the receiving orders that have not yet had labels printed.



The process to clear the label file will now prompt the user for the receiving number to clear.



## **Bulletin 0003 – Label Printing continued**

Should the user wish to print labels from inventory using the 'Preload By Item' option, pressing <CR> will assign a dummy receiving number and then allow you to enter items. This dummy receiving number will allow the user to group or batch items. These labels can then be printed using the 'By Receiving' print option using the dummy receiving number.
